Physical Education Uniform Guide

There are many reasons Cathedral College Wangaratta has established a separate and distinct uniform for Physical Education lessons.

- The PE uniform's materials and style enable greater flexibility and range of movement improving participation and physical safety.
- A complete change of clothing from PE classes to regular classes is essential for student hygiene and comfort.
- A standardised, consistent uniform encourages confidence in students of all levels of ability.
- They are more easily washed and durable than the regular uniform.

Sports Uniform	
Polo Shirt	Sky blue and navy with College Crest
Shorts	Navy with College Crest
Rugby Top	Navy with red and sky blue with white collar and College Crest
Track Pants	Navy with College Crest (Primary and Secondary styles) (Optional for Years Six to Twelve)
Socks	White with College colours
Shoes	Quality cross trainers with non-marking soles

The PE department has developed a clear three step process for Year Six to Year Twelve Physical Education classes. This has been developed to encourage students to wear the correct PE uniform and provide appropriate consequences when they do not.

First occasion A verbal discussion with no follow-on consequences

Second occasion A phone call or email home but no direct consequences to the student

Third occasion Student completes a detention or yard duty

Other points

- Being out of uniform does not preclude the students from participating in lessons and they will still be expected to do so.
- This process starts afresh at the beginning of each term.
- Students who have a valid reason for being out of uniform or whose performance is affected by a medical condition, require their parents to email the students PE teacher prior to the PE class if possible. Valid matters (i.e. medical reasons) will not incur a uniform offence.
